## Brittney Dixon Memorial Dance Scholarship Application

## The Award

Lisa Taylor and Dave Dixon provide an annual \$500 scholarship award (paid directly to Centerstage) for a deserving student for one full dance year in honor of their late daughter Brittney Dixon, former Centerstage dancer and friend.

## **Eligibility**

- Applicant must be a current Centerstage dance student and must be registered with Centerstage for the following dance year.
- Applicant must have danced with Centerstage for at least one full dance year.
- Applicant must be willing to accept responsibility of the scholarship and complete a full dance year at Centerstage, representing the studio, dancers and staff appropriately.
- Selection is based on the applicant's interest and participation in dance (does not need to be competitive); attendance, attitude, and effort in class; treatment of and respect for instructors and fellow dance students; citizenship; leadership; and scholastic achievement.

## **Application Process**

- Complete the form in its entirety and answer all questions as thoroughly as possible.
- Please print as neatly as possible (or type).
- Applicant and parent or legal guardian must sign the Certification and Release Authorization at the end of the form.
- All applications must be returned to the Centerstage office no later than April 1.
- The scholarship award will be presented at one of the recitals in the spring.
- Remember your application represents you! We will ask your dance instructors questions about you as a student and may observe you in class. Dancers do not need to be on competitive teams to apply for this scholarship.
